(The Lord of Glory)**

Bible Reading: Mark 2v9-13

Engage Notes for Young People

The Lord of Glory

Read Mark 9v2-8

Q – What amazing things did these three disciples witness? (v2-3)

Q – Who else was there? (v4)

Q – What did God the Father say about Jesus? (v7)

Q – What must Jesus' followers do?

Jesus was “transfigured”; His whole appearance changed – dazzlingly pure, glorious, unique. And two Jewish heroes were there. Moses had given God's law to the Israelites and Elijah was God's messenger to His people. They had both pointed forward to someone even more important than them – Jesus.

And the disciples heard God's voice, confirming that Jesus really was His Son. So they should listen to Him. And so should we.

Read Mark 9v9-13

Q – What didn't these guys understand? (v10)

Q – What else puzzled them? (v11)

The Jews believed that Elijah would return before the arrival of God Himself. Jesus says that John the Baptist was the “Elijah” who prepared the way for Jesus. Most people didn't realise John's importance, just as they rejected Jesus and would kill Him (v12). But here was the confirmation: the transfiguration showed who Jesus is and what He'd come for.

Q – How do you ignore Jesus?

Q – What will you do about it?

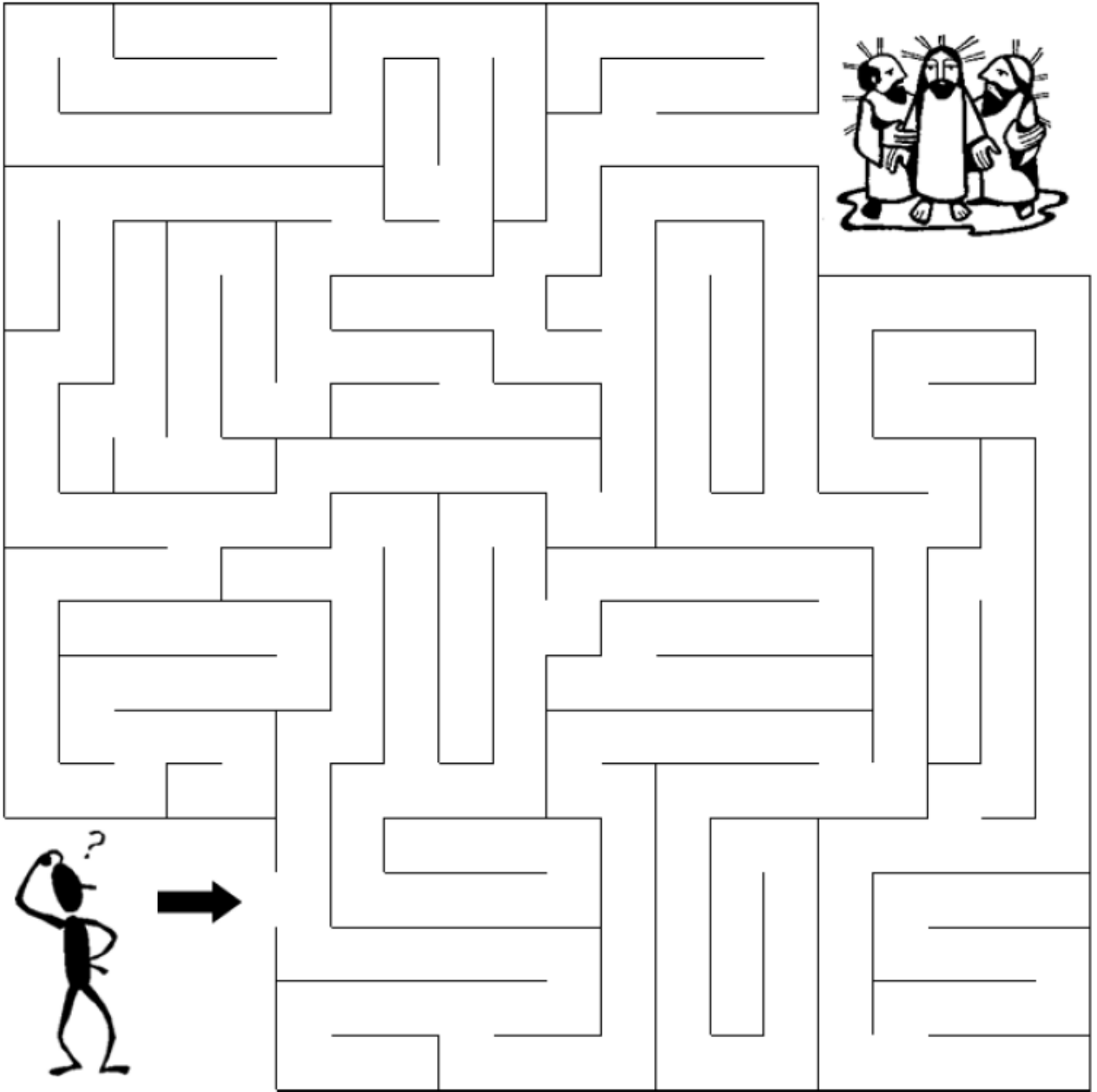

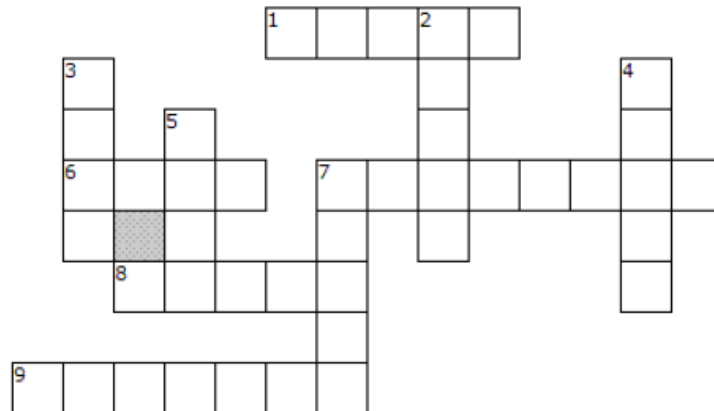
